

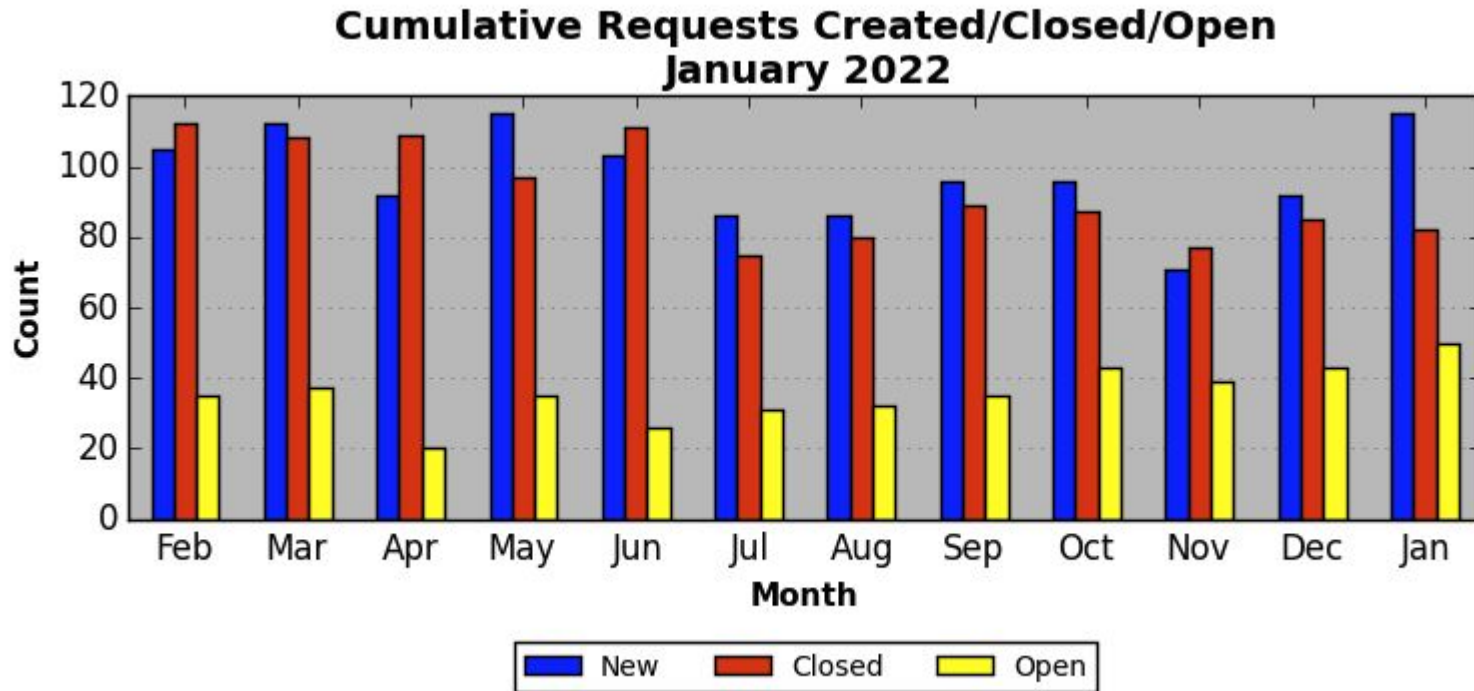

IANA Services Activity

Protocol Parameter requests since IETF 112
(October 2021 – January 2022)

Processed more than 912 IETF-related requests.







This includes: document reviews, registry creation, new registrations, modifications to existing registrations, and deletions.

- Reviewed 45 I-Ds in Last Call
- Reviewed 73 in IESG Evaluation
- Reviewed 54 documents approved for RFC publication
(41 of the 54 documents had registry actions of some form)
- Media Type requests: 14
- Ports + Port modification requests: 26
- New Private Enterprise Numbers: 581

Seven new registry URLs and 26 new registries were added since IETF 112.

Average cumulative percentage for August 2021 through January 2022 was 100%.
